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## **Aim**

**To work to protect the population of Derbyshire County from the risks associated with COVID-19.**



## Objectives

In enacting the plan the following objectives will seek to be achieved;

- Preventing spread of COVID-19
- Contain and suppress outbreaks of COVID-19
- Early identification and proactive management of outbreaks and incidents
- Ensure service capability
- Ensure effective communication with the public and stakeholders

## Roles and Responsibilities

- Public Health England and Local Public Health Authority- Leadership and assurance
- District & Borough Councils- Support and legislative powers
- Health providers- Assistance as local surge capacity
- Environmental Health- Specialist advice, support & investigation
- NHSE & NHSI- Leading the mobilisation of funded services
- CCG-Support and advice -Infection prevention
- CQC- Enforcement role

# Care homes and schools

- 400 social care residential settings
- 1,100 educational settings
- Comprehensive contact list and mapping in place for all settings.
- Audit of channels for communication with settings and service users established.
- Proactive communications around test and trace and preventative measures in development
- Reactice communications including template letters and resources in development
- Notification processes and mapping in established

# Settings of interest

- Risk assessment using available evidence undertaken.
- Identification and mapping of around 4000 settings of interest, and demographic or geographical risk factors undertaken

# Public health measures

- Communications plan in development to provide framework for proactive communications to reduce COVID risk
- Reactive communications developed
- Comprehensive plan aligning to existing regional outbreak plans developed including trigger points, escalation processes, management approach
- Scenario planning of public health measures for various settings aligned to PHE standard operating procedures and national guidance.
- Table top exercise planned to assure around mobilisation capacity

# Local testing capacity

- Mapping of local testing capacity undertaken
- Testing options including home or setting based testing, mobile testing units, fixed testing sites
- Direct links to LRF and specifically testing cell



# Contact tracing

- LA support mapped in discussion with PHE including support for vulnerable persons, communications, risk assessment and specialist advice
- Tiered specialist surge capacity plan in place environmental health, commissioned service support e.g. sexual health and internal Public Health health protection team

# Data and integration

- Sit rep developed for COVID health protection board to enable mapping of outbreaks against community transmission rates, identification of themes and early warning
- Data analysis processes in development.
- Tool developed to support mapping of community transmission rates

# Vulnerable people

- Communications strategy developed identifying potentially vulnerable groups and communities
- Established community response unit in place including food or prescription support, links to adult social care and children's services, welfare rights and citizens advice
