12.20pm	<b>Evaluating the VCSE Memorandum of Understanding in Derby/Derbyshire</b>  The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was launched in June 2023 and set out cultures, behaviours, aspirations and actions necessary for the Integrated Care System, the Integrated Care Board and the VCSE sector to work effectively together as partners. It was recognised that for the MoU to be effective, it would need to be evaluated annually. We will be creating a space to facilitate conversations on the seven key questions relating to VCSE engagement priorities outlined in the MoU.
